Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters Clinton County May 19, 2026 General Primary

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on May 19, 2026 in Clinton County. Military and overseas electors may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or the Clinton County Voter Registration and Election website at <https://www.clintoncountypa.gov/departments/voter-registration>

You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting the FPCA by email to voter@clintoncountypa.gov.

Military and overseas electors may request an absentee ballot at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB), available at www.votespa.com, www.fvap.gov, or <https://www.clintoncountypa.gov/departments/voter-registration>.

Military electors may use the FWAB to register to vote and vote simultaneously. The FWAB can be used to vote for ALL federal, state, and local offices and ballot initiatives. To vote using the FWAB, fill out and send in the Voter Information and the Official Backup Ballot.

To vote for offices or ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the appropriate section of the FWAB. Under the Federal Offices heading, enter the candidate name or political party you choose. Under the Other Offices heading, enter the state or local office, and then the candidate name or political party you choose. Under the Ballot Initiative heading, enter the title of the ballot initiative (referendum) you are voting on and then write YES or NO.

NOTE: THIS NOTICE WILL BE UPDATED WITH THE NAMES OF CANDIDATES WHEN THEY BECOME AVAILABLE.

THE NOTICE MUST BE CONSULTED REGULARLY BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CANDIDATE LISTS MAY CHANGE.
